

Packing list

Space on board is always limited, think about that when packing, and only bring what you need. Use a soft bag, like a sports bag, as it is easier to tuck away, avoid big, hard bags. Remember, it might be cold at sea, in particular when the wind is blowing. Dress in layers.

Recommended items and clothing

Rainwear (jacket and trousers)

Rain hat (unless there is a hood on the jacket)

Boots (preferably rain boots)

Warm sweater

Warm, windproof jacket

Trousers (jeans for example, the wind blows straight through sweatpants)

Warm hat (scarves and the like are not warm enough and will blow away...)

Warm socks

Mittens

Long sleeved shirt

Long underwear

Underwear for change

Swim wear

Sleeping bag

Pillowcase

Sheets perhaps

Pyjamas

Toothbrush

Toiletries (sunscreen is advisable)

Towel

Water bottle

This is optional, but recommended too

Fishing gear

Musical instruments

Torch or headlamp

Teddy bear or other cuddly toy

Camera
