



Constantia's summer voyage 2014:

The summer of 2014, Constantia will leave from her home port in Stockholm, Sweden, to sail south on the Baltic Sea and continue through "Göta kanal", a canal that links the Baltic sea with Kattegatt, from coast to coast in Sweden. We will then participate in the Scandinavian youth ships race "Nordisk seglats" (Nordic Sailing) and the Danish ships race "Fyn Rundt" (around the island Funen). From there we go to the old town Stralsund in Germany, to take part in their newly founded sailing festival.

There are many exciting trips to join for people of all ages!

No prior knowledge or sailing experience is needed to join in!

1 Göta canal, Vänern and Trollhätte canal 27 June – 2 July

Too late, sorry!

2 "Nordisk Seglats" (the Nordic sailing competition) part 1, Gothenburg – Stavern – Skärhamn 2 – 8 July

From Gothenburg we hope to get good winds and sail nicely all the way across Skagerack to Norwegian Stavern, where tall ships with lots of young people (age 12+) from Scandinavia gather for the sailing race. The first stop in the race is Skärhamn in Bohuslän (Sweden). In the harbours, you can engage in several joint activities.

Start in Gothenburg Wednesday 2 July 1 p.m. Finish in Skärhamn Tuesday 8 July 12.00 a.m.

Cost: 6 000 kr adults, 3 000 kr youth up to 25 years of age (youth have priority)

3 "Nordisk Seglats" (the Nordic Sailing competition) part 2, Skärhamn – Ålborg 8 -11 July

This is the second part of the race "Nordisk seglats", ending with festivities in Ålborg in Denmark.

Start in Skärhamn Tuesday 8 July 1 p.m. Ending in Ålborg Friday 11 July 6 p.m.

Cost: 3 500 kr adults, 1 750 kr youth up to 25 years old (youth have priority)

4 The Danish archipelago part 1, Ålborg – Odense 12 – 19 July

On the way, we visit remarkable Danish islands: Läsö, a mythical island with a special botanical interest, and a big exporter of Norwegian lobster. Anholt, with northern Europe's biggest desert, and Samsö, where you find the biggest labyrinth in the world. Samsö is an island which is almost energy self-sufficient with renewable energy.

Start in Ålborg Saturday 12 July 8 p.m. Finish in Odense Saturday 19 July 4 p.m.

Cost: 7 000 kr adults, 3 500 kr youth up to 25 years of age

5 The sailing competition "Fyn Rundt" (around the island Funen), Odense – Svendborg 20 – 26 July

The sailing competition where Danish "gemyt" (character, temper) is in its prime. You sail during the days (after a sturdy breakfast of course) and hang out and have a nice time in the small harbours at night. For single passengers as well as families. In 2012 Constantia was awarded with an honorable second place among about thirty ships. Odense – Middelfart – Assens – Marstal – Faaborg – Svendborg.

Start in Odense Sunday 20 July 9 a.m. Ending in Svendborg Saturday 26 July 4 p.m.

Cost: 7 000 kr adults, 3 500 kr youth up to 25 years old (there is a possibility to get a family discount, on this as well as other trips)

6 The Danish archipelago part 2, Svendborg – Stralsund 27 – 31 July

We find our way south among the southern Danish islands and let the wind decide the route. There are several nice harbours to choose among, such as the old seafarer's town Marstal, where Constantia was once constructed in 1908. Our final destination is Stralsund, an important Hanse town during the Middle Ages, a city that was part of Sweden in the 17th and 18th century.

Start in Svendborg Sunday 27 July 9 a.m. Ending in Stralsund Thursday 31 July 6 p.m.

Cost: 5 000 kr adults, 2 500 kr youth up to 25 years old

Stralsund 1 – 3 August

We take part in the sailing festival in Stralsund and arrange daytrips. For participants in legs 6 and 7, there may be a possibility to stay overnight (though this cannot be guaranteed) and enjoy the festivities in Stralsund.

7 Rügen – Bornholm/Blekinge – Kalmar 4 – 9 August

On the way we can visit the idyllic island Hiddensee and see the famous chalk cliffs of Rügen, now part of a World Heritage Site appointed by UNESCO. Depending on the

weather and the wind we visit Bornholm and Christiansö or find our way north along beautiful Österlen and the archipelago of Blekinge.

Start in Stralsund Monday 4 August 9 a.m. Ending in Kalmar Saturday 9 August 6 p.m.

Cost: 6 000 kr adults, 3 000 kr youth up to 25 years old

8 The archipelago of the Swedish east coast 10 – 14 August

From the picturesque, medieval town Kalmar passed the island Blå Jungfrun (the blue maiden) and then onwards north through the archipelagos along the coast. We sail during the days and anchor in natural harbours in the evenings, and enjoy the warm, nights and perhaps a bath in the moonlight.

Start in Kalmar Sunday 10 August 9 a.m. Ending in Eknäs, Ingarö outside of Stockholm, Thursday 14 August 6 p.m.

Cost: 5 000 kr adults, 2 500 kr for youth up to 25 years of age

- All prices are in Swedish crowns (kr)
- Food is included in the price (usually 3 meals and coffee/tea breaks), but the travelling costs to and from the ship are not included. Everyone takes part in the cooking as well as in the running of the ship.
- We offer a 10% discount on the prices above when booking before 1 April. For information on family discounts, please contact us!
- There might be smaller changes in the program!
- The day before departure, it may be possible to stay overnight, if there is space available (however this cannot be guaranteed).
